

FLOWER FAIRIES NATURE CROWN

Whatever the season, you can crown yourself an honorary flower fairy with this fun activity. From a woodland fairy with a crown of sticks and pinecones, to a garden fairy with a crown of daisies and sprigs of lavender, it's all up to you!

You will need ...

INSTRUCTIONS

Card

🚱 Scissors

Double sided sticky tape

Flowers, grasses, bark, feathers & leaves Begin by going out on a nature walk to collect things to decorate your crown. You'll be able to find all sorts of different things depending on the season. These could be flowers, grasses, leaves, or even feathers – whatever you like.

Now that you're home, it's time to start making the crown. Cut your paper or card into strips. These will form the base of your crown. You can make these strips

thinner or wider depending on how tall you want your crown to be!

Next, you will need to measure the strips around your head where you want the crown to sit, and use the tape to secure it in a ring.

Now that you have made the base of your crown, run the double-sided sticky tape all around the outside of the paper band.

Finally it is time to decorate. Stick your treasures all around the sides using extra tape if needed and your crown is ready to wear!
